President Luanne made opening remarks. Reminded members of the Lakes Assn. Picnic coming up on August 4th, etc.

Treasurer Maxine advised there are 148 Association Members. 30 are unpaid.

Elections for various positions were announced (President, Treasure and 3 Trustees) and nominations requested with no new takers. All positions will remain filled with those presently in them.

Maryann Clark from the Lakes Board talked about milfoil and treatment of same. Expense was discussed and areas to be treated this year on July 11th in Lakes Mary and Louise. This board will further investigate additional signage at boat launches.

Lindsey from the Dickinson Conservation District was present and gave a short presentation on what they have to offer such as shoreline improvement options, types of invasive aquatic species, tree and wildflower sales, etc. The need for dedicated funds from the State for lakes management. Letters to our lawmakers from our Assn. and lake front owners would help.

A suggestion was made to send a letter from the assn. to the Dickinson County Road commission thanking them for the road resurfacing recently done on the road. There was also much discussion regarding speed on said stretch of road as well as getting work done of the Waucedah road. Seasonal speed bumps are a possible solution to the speeding issue.
